This initiative has spurred job creation, diversified industries beyond tourism, and boosted sectors like free trade zones and remittances. The country's customs department has played a crucial role by implementing a new regulatory framework, advanced technologies for non-intrusive inspections, and integrating new technological systems. As a result, the Dominican Republic has become a key player in the Caribbean and Latin America, with strong supply chains, thriving free zones,

local industries, and a growing domestic market. Companies are increasingly focusing on improving their logistics and inventory management near their target markets through the concept of nearshoring. The country's capacity to handle larger volumes of air, sea, and land cargo has made it highly competitive, with air transportation often proving more cost-effective and efficient than domestic distribution within the United States. The efficiency of the logistics sector is underscored by the potential for a 30% increase in

exports with a mere 10% reduction in transportation costs. Moreover, the Dominican Republic boasts excellent multimodal connections throughout Latin America, connecting various logistics nodes in the region. A Logistics Hub Segment Study is currently underway, examining the country's competitive conditions and identifying potential target markets. This commitment to continual improvement has resulted in the country achieving its highest volume of goods in transit in 2022, solidifying its position as a vital transit connection hub.
